Announcing Our 2025 Scholarship Recipients

We are excited to welcome Alexander Wall, Audrey Wolff, and William Johnson. For the first time since 2002, we were able to award 3 scholarships. Thank you to all our donors for supporting our mission.



Alexander Wall is a high school senior at Prosper High School in Texas. He is a student pilot who plans to study Professional Flight at Southeastern Oklahoma State University and pursue a career as a commercial airline pilot. His love for aviation began at a young age, inspired by his father's service in the U.S. Navy. He is the video production director for Prosper ISD's stadium, where he leads a 10-person team that produces a live broadcast for the jumbotron. In his spare time, he loves to scuba dive and take his truck off-roading. Alexander started a landscaping business in seventh grade and grew it to serve over 250 customers. With over 600 volunteer hours, he serves as the Youth Missions Chair at his church, where he organizes and leads annual mission trips and fundraising efforts. He also volunteers weekly as a video and audio technician and maintains the church's 8 acres of grass.

Audrey Wolff is currently a senior at the Classical Academy College Pathways where she has lettered in Varsity Tennis and Flag Football. She currently volunteers through Special Olympics, National Charity League, National Honor Society, and the Wild Blue Cat Shelter. Additionally, she is actively involved with the High Flights Soaring Club and the Air Academy Cadet Squadron of Civil Air Patrol. After high school, Audrey aspires to attend the Air Force Academy and major in Aeronautical or Mechanical Engineering.
